



****PUBLIC NOTICE****

The voters of the Town of Taylor in 2020 adopted an Alternative Expenditure Limitation - Home Rule Option. The purpose of this election is for the continued use of the Alternative Expenditure Limitation – Home Rule Option.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-563.01, the Town Council of Taylor voted to approve the proposed Alternative Expenditure Limitation – Home Rule Option at its special meeting on March 12, 2024. The council vote was 6 For and 0 Against.

At the primary election to be held on July 30, 2024, the citizens of the Town of Taylor will vote on a proposed Alternative Expenditure Limitation - Home Rule Option.

With voter approval, the town expenditures each year shall be limited to the estimated available revenues whether such expenditures are less than or exceed the State-imposed limit. As an example, in FY 2025-2026, the State-imposed limitation plus applicable Constitutional exclusions would allow expenditures of \$2,151,314. Under the proposed Alternative Expenditure Limitation – Home Rule Option, we estimate revenue and expenditures of \$12,560,648.

If the voters approve, the additional expenditure authority will be used for all local budgetary purposes including public safety, culture & recreation, public works, airport and general government.

Revenues received from Federal, State, and local sources will be used to fund such expenditures. (The city/town property tax amount shall continue to be limited to the amount prescribed in the Arizona State Constitution.) By order of the Town Council of Taylor.
