CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Palmer called the meeting to order at 7:05pm

CALL TO THE PUBLIC: April Williams said the bleachers looks fantastic and is concerned about the handicap signs; ADA law is 5% and handicap must have line sight. Gus said the plan is to have handicap inset with blue markings.

Motion by Councilman DeWitt to approve the consent agenda as presented; seconded by Councilman Hancock

DISCUSSION/ACTION ITEMS

1. Introduction of New Building Official

Gus introduced Josh McGinnis. Josh said for the past 5-6 years he has been an inspector with the County and has many years of building experience.

2. Public Hearing Regarding Ordinance O2024-02 Amending Town Code 8.05 Garbage Receptacles in Town Right-of-Way

Councilman Baldwin made a motion to move item #5 up to #2 seconded by Councilwoman Cospier-Duke.

Mayor Palmer opened the public hearing. Receiving no public comment the hearing was closed.

3. Second Reading by Title Only Followed by Consideration and Action of Adopting Ordinance O2024-02 Amending Town Code 8.05 Garbage Receptacles in Town Right-of-Way

Vice Mayor Brubaker read Ordinance O2024-02 by title only.

Motion by Councilman Baldwin to adopt Ordinance O2024-02 Amending Town Code 8.05 Garbage Receptacles in Town Right-of-Way; seconded by Vice Mayor Brubaker; motion carried 7-0 with Mayor Palmer, Vice Mayor Brubaker, and Council Members Baldwin, Cospier Duke, Hancock, Neff, and DeWitt voting in favor.

4. Discussion and Action Regarding Adoption of Fiscal Year 2025 Tentative Budget

Gus recommended this item be postponed.

5. Discussion and Action Regarding the Establishment of a Budget for Proposed Disk Golf Course

Gus said Jarod Robinson and Terrill Nichols have assisted with a map for disk golf course; Gus is asking for Council authorization to have a budget transfer for the project.

Jarod Robinson gave an overview and brief presentation of disk golf. NPC has had tournaments; Mr. Robinson is willing to work with them for the Town to have a successful tournament.

Gus said the 4 acres at Airport & Willow could be a parking area for the disk golf course; there are future plans for a road off of Pinedale. Councilman DeWitt asked about restrooms; Gus said restrooms have been discussed and will be needed.

Gus said there are two companies that sell a high end product; budget estimated for the course would be \$60,000 for baskets, signage and slabs for the “T” box.

Motion by Councilwoman Cospir Duke to establish a budget for a disk golf course; seconded by Councilman Neff; motion carried 7-0 with Mayor Palmer, Vice Mayor Brubaker, and Council Members Baldwin, Cospir Duke, Hancock, Neff, and DeWitt voting in favor.

6. Summary of Current Events:
